

Signing up to the Lawrence Batley Theatre Under 30s scheme is subject to terms and conditions. When signing up you are agreeing to these terms and conditions:

- 1. The Lawrence Batley Theatre Under 30s scheme is open to anyone aged 18-29 years. Once you turn 30 you will no longer be eligible for the scheme.
- 2. By registering for the scheme you agree that you are aged 18-29 years and that any tickets discounted as part of the scheme are for your sole use plus one other. Any other tickets booked will be charged at the applicable rate.
- 3. Your Under 30s card must be collected from the theatre. To collect the card you must have signed up to the scheme through our website or via our Box Office. When attending a show you will need to present a valid Under 30s card along with your Under 30s ticket. You will also need to present a valid Under 30s card to receive your discount on food & drink. Valid ID must be presented when collecting the card.
- 4. You must remember to log in to your account and update your date of birth in the 'details' section so we can update your membership expiry,
- 5. The forms of ID we accept are Photo Driving Licence or passport (with photo).
- 6. £5 tickets will only be available for select shows. All valid shows will be displayed on the Under 30s page on the Lawrence Batley Theatre website, emailed to you in a regular newsletter and posted in the Under 30s Facebook group.
- 7. There will only be a limited number of tickets for each show available at the Under 30s rate so book early to avoid disappointment.
- 8. You can buy a maximum of two tickets per show at the Under 30s rate. If you're bringing someone along who is over 30, that's absolutely fine, just as long as the person who holds the Under 30s membership is attending with them and a valid Under 30s card is presented.
- 9. When attending a show you must present your valid Under 30s card and Under 30s ticket. If no Under 30s card or an expired Under 30s card is presented admission can be refused and your membership may be cancelled.
- 10. Tickets can be booked online at thelbt.org, at the Lawrence Batley Theatre box office in person or by telephone on 01484 430 528.
- 11. 10% off in our Courtyard Café-Bar is only available when a valid Under 30s card is presented. If no Under 30s card is presented the discount will not be applied.
- 12. If the Under 30s card is lost a £5 charge will apply to replace the card.
- 13. Access to the private Under 30s Facebook group is subject to other terms & conditions. These can be viewed in the Facebook group.
- 14. By registering for the scheme you are agreeing to being contacted via email by Lawrence Batley Theatre for marketing purposes. All Under 30s must agree to being contacted by email for Under 30 offers and promotions. You can opt out of receiving emails by selecting 'Unsubscribe' at the bottom right of the email communications, but this will mean that your membership of the Under 30s scheme will be cancelled.
- 15. All data given will be used in accordance with the 1998 Data Protection Act and GDPR.
- 16. Our standard terms and conditions of sale also apply to all bookings.
- 17. If any free tickets are obtained as part of the scheme these cannot be exchanged and our standard terms and conditions in relation to exchanges do not apply to such tickets.
