They become friends, and Much and Scarlet tell Robyn about the Sheriff and his unfair laws and how he takes everyone's food and money. Scarlet demonstrates a loud warning signal 'Ca-caw, Ca-caw' which means the Sheriff's guards are coming and everyone must hide!



They tell how Marion tried to stand up to the Sheriff, but he had loads of guards and Marion only had a bow and arrow. Robyn goes to Marion, thinking that if she has the bow and arrow, she'll be able to defeat the Sheriff. Marion hands it over.

Robyn tries to stand up to him, but in the end the Sheriff wins. He takes the gold back and tramples all over the outlaws' hiding place. Things are worse than before.




Robyn feels bad and runs away. She finds Marion who gives Robyn a map of the castle.
